

- 307.—*Mary Elizabeth Pierson*, b. Nov. 19, 1823; m. Charles B. Bates of Sharon mountain April 27, 1843, and died in Kent May 25, 1844; buried in Sharon.
- 308.—*Harriet Louisa Pierson*, b. Feb. 17, 1826; m. Henry Kirke White of White Hollow Nov. 26, 1851, and had Josephine, Elizabeth, Albert Pierson and Frances Louisa, all born in Sharon Great Hollow.
- 309.—*John Albert Pierson*, b. April 6, 1828; m. widow Jane Groesbeck (maiden name Jane Briggs) of Saratoga, N. Y., and had one son, Albert Briggs, b. in Torrington, Conn., and drowned there.
- 310.—*Caroline Pierson*, b. Aug. 7, 1830; m. Frederick A. Hotchkiss of Sharon Valley March 27, 1850; she died in Bridgeport Dec. 18, 1867, and was buried in Sharon. Their children were *Mary*, *Carrie*, *Louisa*, *Franklin Augustus*, and *Hattie*. Mary married Henry Hill of Reading, Conn.; Frank m. ——— Gillette of Sharon; Hattie m. ——— McKelvie.
- 311.—*Sarah Augusta Pierson*, b. Feb. 13, 1833; m. Marcus Coon Oct. 26, 1853, and died in Bridgeport Aug. 27, 1866; buried in Sharon; no heirs.
- 312.—*Frances Aphelia Pierson*, b. Dec. 5, 1834; m. Josiah Hawley Mills of North East, N. Y., Nov. 27, 1856. They had one son, who died young, and Emma Cordelia.
- 313.—*Cordelia Pierson*, b. Nov. 5, 1837; unmarried.
- 314.—*Augustus Pierson*, b. Oct. 31, 1840; d. Aug. 8, 1842.

John Pierson d. in Stanwich Dec. 14, 1888, at 3:30 p. m.; buried in Stanwich. Sarah Lockwood d. in Stanwich May 21, 1883, in Amenia of typhoid pneumonia; buried in Stanwich. John Pierson was 5 ft. 8 in. high, weight 150 lbs; hair dark brown, gray eyes, nose slightly roman. Sarah Lockwood was above average height, weight 175 lbs, hair dark reddish-brown. blue eyes. The Lockwoods are descended from Robert Lockwood and Susannah St. John, who were in Watertown, Mass., in 1630. Sarah's father was Frederick Lockwood and her mother was Deborah Reynolds, dau. of Nathaniel Reynolds and Sarah Lockwood [*this* Sarah Lockwood was sister of Thaddeus Lockwood]. Frederick Lockwood's father was Jonathan and his mother was Mercy Finch of New Canaan, Conn. Jon-
