TIMOTHY ALVORD (*Uebadiah, John, Jonathan, Alexander*), born Northampton, Mass., July 13, 1751; died Northampton, Mass., May 5, 1821; married June 13, 1781, Keziah French of Southampton, Mass., daughter of Ebenezer and Mary (Edwards) French. She was born Mar. 27, 1748; died Hinckley, O., about 1830. Res. Northampton, Mass., and Easthampton, Mass. Children:

In 1787 Timothy Alvord of Easthampton, Mass., sold his house and land on the hill (near Noutawanuck) to Samuel Mather. Timothy Alvord kept a record of deaths at Northampton, 1802-3, 1807-8-9, 1812-13. The Bible is still in possession of the Kellogg family of Hinckley, O.

Rev War Service: "Alverd, Timothy, Hatfield, Private, Capt. Israel Chapin's Co., Col. John Fellows' Reg., which marched Apr. 20, 1775, in response to the alarm of Apr. 19, 1775; service 7 days. Also drummer, Capt. Ebenezer Strong's Co., Col. Sears' (Hampshire Co.) Reg. Enlisted Aug. 10, 1781; dis. Nov. 20, 1781; service 3 mos. 10 days at Saratoga. Marched to Albany Aug. 17, 1781."

"Alvard, Timothy, Hatfield, Private, Capt. Israel Chapin's Co., Col. John Fellows' Reg. Muster roll dated Aug. 1, 1775. Enlisted Apr. 27, 1775. Service 3 mos. 12 days. Also Co. return dated Oct. 8, 1775. Also order for bounty coat or its equivalent in money dated Dorchester, Dec. 18, 1775. Also drummer, Capt. Benson's Co.; Col. Putnam's Reg. Continental Army. Pay accounts for service from Jan. 1, 1780 to Dec. 14, 1780."

"Alvord, Timothy, Northampton, Drummer, Capt. Benjamin Bonney's Co., Col. Samuel Brewer's Reg. Pay abstract for travel allowance, dated Chestersfield, Mar. 13, 1777. Service with the Northern Army at Ticonderoga. Also Capt. Joshua Benson's Co., Col. Putnam's Reg. Continental Army. Pay accounts for service from June 27, 1777 to Dec. 31, 1779. Reported deserted Jan. 1, 1780, but returned and completed 3 years' term. Also muster return dated Albany, Feb., 1778." (Mass. Soldiers in Rev.)
