CYNTHIA ALVORD (*Jonathan, Jonathan, Jonathan, Alexander*), born Westhampton, Mass., May 31, 1780; died Huntsburg, O., May 20, 1861; married Westhampton, Mass., Oct. 23, 1811, Daniel Townsley, son of Moses and Abigail Townsley. He was born Sept. 23, 1783; died about 1879. Res. Westhampton, Mass. and Huntsburg, O. Children:
