Asenath (Smith) Alvord was the granddaughter of David Smith. Her mother Eunice and her mother's sister Maria, wife of John Alvord, inherited their father's (Samuel Judd) estate at South Farms in Northampton. It was on this place that Lewis Smith resided until his death, Mar. 15, 1838. He had eleven children, all of whom lived to marry. Five of his sons settled side by side in South Farms, Northampton, on the west side of the Conn. River, now called Smiths' Ferry. The widow of Cyrus Alvord was residing in 1868 on the old place of her husband's great grandfather, John Alvord, with her husband's brother, Luther Alvord, in South Hadley, on the east side of the Conn. River, south of Smith's Ferry landing.
