

Benjamin Alvord was a live-stock dealer and lived at Cazenovia, and in several other places in N. Y. state before going West.

501. SAMUEL ALVORD (*Daniel, Elisha, Joseph, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born March 16, 1784; died Hamilton, Ill., Aug. 13, 1872; married 1st, Sept. 1809, Sally Bates. She was born Sept. 1789; died near Lockport, N. Y., Mar. 8, 1813 (buried on the farm). He married 2nd, Nov. 20, 1813, Ursula (Smith) Crowl, widow of James Crowl, and daughter of Oliver Smith. She was born in Conn., Jan. 12, 1794; died Hamilton, Ill., Aug. 6, 1864. Res. Hamilton, Ill. Children:

In early life Samuel Alvord lived near Lockport, N. Y., on a farm adjoining that of his brother, Daniel. He was a soldier in the war of 1812, Sept. 12 to Oct. 22, 1812, in Rufus Spalding's Co., Silas Hopkins' Reg. N. Y. Militia, and a pioneer Baptist preacher for over sixty years. He was the first minister at Clymer, N. Y., 1828. A pure life was his example. Sincerely devoted to his religion, he lived for others. "Heaven is his reward."

Oliver Smith, father of Mrs. Ursula (Smith) Crowl Alvord, was a Revolutionary soldier. She herself was a thorough Christian, a faithful wife, a devoted and affectionate mother. Samuel and Ursula Alvord, while each was the second companion to the other, had the rare experience of celebrating their "Golden Wedding," Nov. 20, 1863.

503. MARY ALVORD (*Daniel, Elisha, Joseph, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Westhampton, Mass., Aug. 1, 1788; died Greene, O., May 11, 1843; married Georgetown, N. Y., Oct. 4, 1809, Abishaï Sabine Underwood, son of Daniel and Experience (Kingsley) Underwood. He was born Woodstock, Conn., Apr. 24, 1778; died Waushara, Wis., Mar. 15, 1852. Res. Cazenovia, N. Y.
