Lyman Alvord was a farmer. He died at the home of his daughter, Polly Seeley. The following record of service in the War of 1812 is furnished by Adj. Gen., Washington, D. C.:

"The name Lyman Alvord, as that of a private, appears on rolls of Captain Phelps's Company, Fleming's Detachment, New York Volunteers and Militia, War of 1812. The rolls show as follows in his case: 'Commencement of service, May 20, 1812; to what time enlisted, September 1, 1812; remarks, deserted.'

"The name of Lyman Alvert appears on a muster roll of Captain Davison's Company, Fleming's Detachment, New York Volunteers and Militia, for July 18 to September 18, 1812, War of 1812. The rolls show as follows in his case: 'Present; remarks, Joined from Captain Phelps's Company.'

"The name Lyman Alvord (name also borne as Alverd and Olverd) appears as that of a private, on the rolls of Captain Elias Benjamin, Jr.'s Company, in the Albany Regiment (Mills's), Artillery and Infantry Regiment, New York Volunteers, War of 1812. The rolls show as follows in his case: 'Commencement of service, February 1, 1813; Expiration of service, August 9, 1813; remarks, Four days allowed to go from Utica to German, Chenango County, his residence, 80 miles.'

In the list of awards to N. Y. soldiers in the War of 1812, Lyman Alvord of Greenwood received \$55.

Edmund Alvord removed with his parents from Conn. to Cincinnatus, N. Y., when six years old (1802). Here he remained until 1833, when he went to Moravia, N. Y. In 1840 he removed to
