

1811. TRISTRAM BROWNING ALVORD (*Chester, Bezaleel, Azariah, John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born South Hadley, Mass., Sept. 27, 1804; died Geneseo, N. Y., Dec. 1838; married Geneseo, N. Y., Feb. 6, 1836, Mary Lucretia Austin, daughter of Russel and Phebe (Hills) Austin. She was born Goshen, Conn., Apr. 1, 1809; died Geneseo, N. Y., July 9, 1881. Res. Geneseo, N. Y. No children.

Tristram Browning Alvord was a dealer in produce. Nov. 16, 1826, Erastus Parsons deeded land in Geneseo, N. Y., to "Brownen" Alvord.

1812. DOLLY ALVORD (*Chester, Bezaleel, Azariah, John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born South Hadley, Mass., Jan. 26, 1807; died Geneseo, N. Y., Nov. 26, 1837; married prob. Geneseo, N. Y., about 1835, William Henry Kelsey, son of Solomon and Virtue (Record) Kelsey. He was born Smyrna, N. Y., Oct. 2, 1812; died Geneseo, N. Y., Apr. 20, 1879. Res. Geneseo, N. Y. No children.

William H. Kelsey was a newspaper man and a lawyer. In 1860 he was a member of Congress. He married 2nd June 2, 1850, Phebe T. McNair.

1815. AZARIAH BENJAMIN BRAINARD ALVORD (*Helaz, Bezaleel, Azariah, John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born in Mass.; married — ——. Res. Hazlehurst, Miss. Children:

(There were several children, but names unknown.)

When a young man Azariah Benjamin Brainard Alvord went South and married a New Orleans lady. He was a slave owner and principal of high school at Hazlehurst, Miss. Last heard from in 1859. During the war, he left Hazlehurst for some place in Georgia. A friend of his nephew, Benjamin H. Alvord, being in Hazlehurst some years ago made inquiry with reference to him. An aged negro was found who had been his slave and bore the family name, but could give no definite information regarding the whereabouts of the family.

1816. HENRY WELLS ALVORD (*Helaz, Bezaleel, Azariah, John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born in Mass., 1821; died Aqua Springs, Windmill Point, Va., Feb., 1863; married New Lebanon, N. Y., 1846, Emily Chapman, daughter of Ambrose and Sabrina (Kingsley) Chapman, of Becket, Mass. She was born Canaan, N. Y., Feb. 4, 1821; died Commeant, Pa., Oct. 16, 1872. Res. Canaan, N. Y., Greenbush (East Albany), N. Y., six miles west of Girard, Pa., and near Albion, Pa. Children:
