Abstract: This is a collection of maps from the Charles Pelot Summerall papers that have been transferred from the Manuscript Division of the Library of Congress. These include manuscript maps, manuscript copies of maps, annotated printed maps, printed maps, and photocopied maps. The maps show various World War I battles and campaigns, including those of Argonne, Meuse, Saint Mihiel, and Verdun; as well as, captured German military maps. The collection also includes maps of Camp Zachary Taylor, Fort Bragg, and southeastern United States ports.
