## Scope and Content Note

The papers of the Pike-McConnell-Donaldson family span the years 1770-1967, with the bulk of the material dated between 1902 and 1909. The papers relate to the family members involvement with China, 1902-1909, and to their estates. The papers are arranged in four series: [Diaries](#), [Correspondence](#), [Miscellany](#) and [Microfilm](#).

Included are [diaries](#) of James S. McConnell and his daughter, Lavinia Pike McConnell Donaldson, 1899-1921.

[Correspondents](#) among the Pike-McConnell-Donaldson family include Edwin Hurd Conger, United States minister to China, 1897-1904, Lavinia Pike McConnell Donaldson, and David K. Donaldson.

Also included are address books, appointment books, scrapbooks, calling cards, photographs, and printed material. Material on [microfilm](#) deals with the estates of various member of the family.
