Scope and Content Note

The papers of Lester Frank Ward (1841-1913) span the years 1883-1906 and consist of drafts, notes, and page proofs of five books written on sociology by Ward. The collection is arranged chronologically by date of publication and includes *Dynamic Sociology* (1883), *Psychic Factors of Civilization* (1893), *Outlines of Sociology* (1898), *Pure Sociology* (1903), and *Applied Sociology* (1906). The materials trace the development of Ward's beliefs regarding egalitarian sociology.
