Scope and Content Note

The papers of Frank Marion Bennett (1857-1924) span the years 1893-1909, with the bulk of the material falling in the period 1897-1907. The collection contains material relating to Bennett's two books, *The Steam Navy of the United States* (1896) and *The Monitor and the Navy Under Steam* (1900), and articles by him. It also includes testimonial letters and scrapbooks containing reviews of Bennett's books.
