Processing History

The Untermeyer-Frost Collection was processed in 1989. The finding aid was revised in 2003 and in 2011.

The Untermeyer-Frost Collection is open to research. Researchers are advised to contact the Manuscript Reading Room prior to visiting. Many collections are stored off-site and advance notice is needed to retrieve these items for research use.

Scope and Content Note

The Untermeyer-Frost Collection spans the years 1913-1964 and consists of letters from Robert Frost (1874-1963) to Louis Untermeyer (1885-1977) dealing with poets and poetry, religion, politics, Frost's philosophy, and other interests of the two men. Included are drafts and galley proofs of *The Letters of Robert Frost to Louis Untermeyer* (1963). Also included are articles, pamphlets, and books of Frost's work and autographed photographs together with correspondence, clippings, and other printed matter concerning Frost that were collected by Untermeyer.
