Correspondence, Subject File, speeches and writing, printed ephemera, and miscellany related to the rare book collection and its creator, Lessing J. Rosenwald. Contains records of the Library of Congress's custodianship of the collection, administrative and legal documents, planning material for related exhibits and publications, and research files.

Provenance

The papers of Lessing J. Rosenwald were given to the Library of Congress by the Rosenwald estate between 1980 and 1983. The material was received by the Rare Book and Special Collections Division and the majority was transferred to the Manuscript Division where it was processed as the Lessing J. Rosenwald Papers. Some Rosenwald material was kept by the Rare Book and Special Collection Division and added to the Division's curatorial files. This archive of the collection was maintained by the Rare Book and Special Collection Division and described in 2010.

Scope and Content Note

The archive of the Lessing J. Rosenwald Collection documents the custodianship of this important collection of rare books by the Rare Book and Special Collections Division of the Library of Congress. In 1943, Rosenwald donated his print and rare book collections to the National Gallery of Art and the Library of Congress in Washington D.C. Having built a repository, Alverthorpe Gallery, at his estate in Jenkintown, Rosenwald retained physical custody of the collections during his lifetime, periodically transferring selections to Washington for exhibition, and ultimately giving 2,600 rare books and 5,000 reference books to the Library. After his death in 1979, Rosenwald's books were physically transferred to the Library of Congress and housed in the Rare Book and Special Collections Division.

Some material in the records originated with Rosenwald's own files at Alverthorpe, but the bulk of the material originated at the Library of Congress. The records were maintained by a number of different curators and administrators. Significant figures include Kathleen T. (Hunt) Mang, who served on Rosenwald's staff at Alverthorpe in the 1970s and later became the Curator of the Rosenwald Collection at the Library of Congress. Peter VanWingen replaced Mang as Rosenwald Curator in 1992. Chiefs of the Rare Book Division during this period include Frederick R. Goff (from 1945 to 1972) and William Matheson (from 1972 to 1987). At Alverthorpe, Rosenwald's print curators included Elizabeth Mongan (from 1937 to 1963) and Ruth Fine (from 1972 to 1980), both of whom later worked at the National Gallery of Art.

The [Correspondence](#) series contains letters concerning the collection between various administrators and curators, including Frederick R. Goff, Elizabeth Mongan, Kathleen T. Mang, and Rosenwald himself.

The [Subject File](#) contains administrative and legal information about the collection, including indentures and details about the 1980 transfer from Alverthorpe to the Library of Congress. It also contains records of various projects undertaken by the Library of Congress, including exhibitions of the collection, the construction of the Rosenwald memorial room, and the publication of the 1991 book, *Vision of a Collector*. In addition, the files contain research material about various individuals and books.

The [Speeches and Writings File](#) contains articles and speeches written by Rosenwald.

The [Miscellany](#) series contains press clippings and publications, miscellaneous ephemera, and speeches and writings by others. The writings by others section consists mainly of offprints and scholarly articles sent to Rosenwald, many inscribed with notes from the authors.

The [Printed Ephemera](#) series contains material produced by various printers, publishers, artists, booksellers, libraries, and bibliographic societies. Many of the items are mailings sent out by private presses such as the Gehenna Press and the Nonesuch Press. The series includes many book prospectuses, some of which are directly linked to items in the Rosenwald Collection.

The [Oversize](#) series contains material removed from other series and folders due to its size.
