In answer to the address, the Governor said, he would take the opinion of the Council on the subject.

### Singular case of Hydrophobia.

[From the N. Y. Med. Rep.]  
Levi Hoodnall, aged forty-three years, died at Southampton, in the State of Long-Island, on the 15th inst. On the 1st of April one thousand seven hundred ninety-seven.

The origin and progress of his disorder were worthy of being recorded. He felt a cold considerably indisposed on Thursday the 7th of April, was affected with a pricking pain in his ear, with a head-ache, and other unusual feelings. On Friday the thirteenth he was abroad. At evening, feeling his indisposition increase, a physician was called in. From a slight degree of hydrophobia, the physician was alarmed with an apprehension of coming madness; but having, on the next day, through a near suspicion, of the patient's having been exposed to be bitten, he judged nothing at that time, of his fears. On the morning of Saturday the 15th he lay low again, and observing an increase of the same symptoms, he suggested the idea to the family. It was then recalled by them, that for a length of time the patient had accustomed a small dog belonging to a neighboring family to lick

an elevated foot, within liberty, that four weeks previous to that time the dog was put to lick the fore; that the operation was more than commonly painful, and that a inflamed breast was made in the skin of the ear by the tongue, or teeth of the dog; that the next day the dog appeared affected with symptoms of madness, and on the following day was killed. No apprehensions of mischief were entertained at the time; but it has been thought of afterwards. The physician was now convinced that the disorder must have proceeded from the virus infused by the dog; but this conviction was obtained at a period too late to admit of an efficient application of remedies. Through the whole of Saturday the patient was continually craving water; but was thrown into the most violent agitation, and horror on the 16th of April. Through the night he was very restless. In the morning of Sunday his disorder increased to a height amounting to all the spectators. He continued in a most delirious condition all day, and in all the evening, and in the evening which attends this most terrible of human maladies.

He appeared to possess a considerable degree of reason through the whole course of the disease, and he was able to converse on every occasion around him, and was apparently sensible that his disposition was fast approaching.

A circumstance peculiarly favorable to his recovery had been thought of, and remembered by them with gratitude, was that he refused no disposition, at any time, to do the smallest injury or mischief to any person, but was constant in expressing the warmest benevolence for his family and neighbors.

Extract of a Letter from a gentleman at New-Jersey to his correspondent in Philadelphia, dated April 1801.

There is now a regular mail established between this city and Natchez, which crosses here on a regular Monday every month, so as to go in a concert with the post which leaves Natchez every second and fourth Monday for the United States. By this means a safe communication is now opened between the United States and this place, which has been hitherto most wanted. I presume letters will be about 5 or 6 weeks between New-York.
