


Heligoland, Which Through the War Was Germany's Strongest Coast Defense



MAP OF HELIGOLAND, THE GREAT ROCK RISING FROM THE SEA, THAT WAS CEDED TO GERMANY BY ENGLAND IN 1890, AND FORTIFIED BY THE FORMER UNTIL IT WAS PRACTICALLY IMPREGNABLE TO HOSTILE ATTACK. DETAILS ARE GIVEN IN DESCRIPTION ABOVE, AND ITS RELATION IS SHOWN TO THE GERMAN AND BRITISH COASTS.
